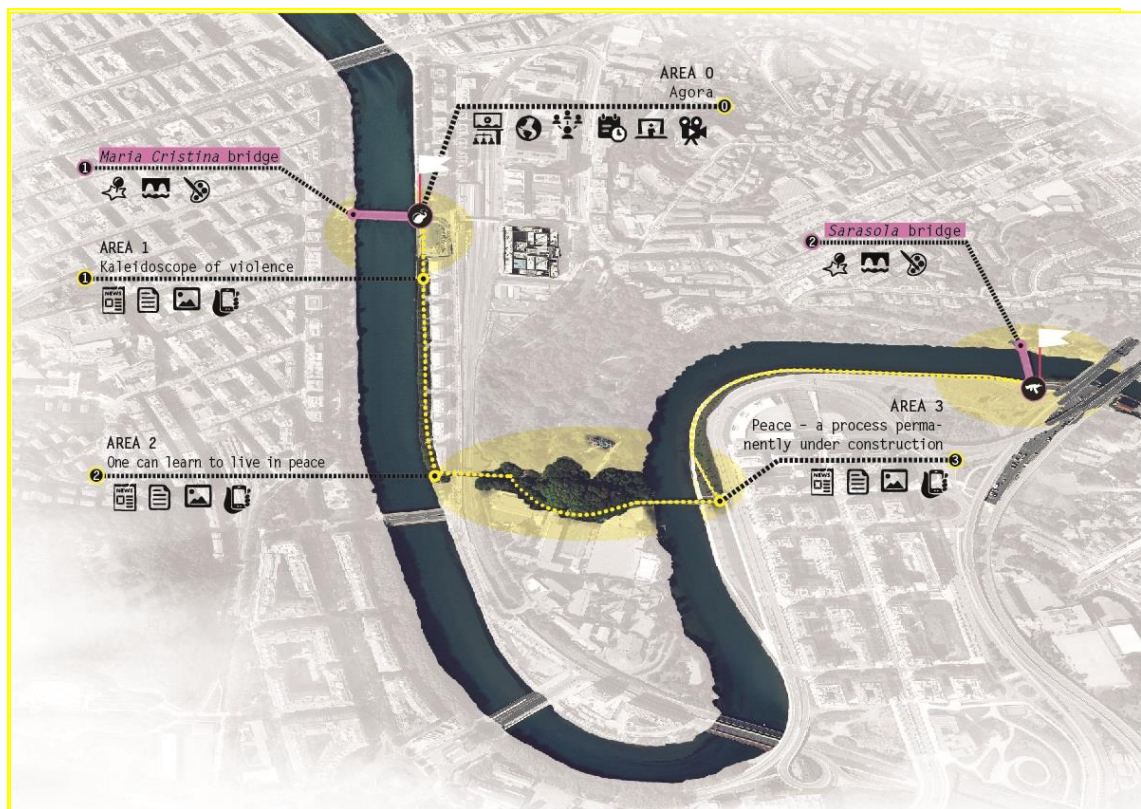

#### MARIA CRISTINA BRIDGE

Inauguration:

1905

Location:

Donostia-San Sebastian. Gipuzkoa. Basque

Country

Main Information:

It has a total length of 88 m, a width of 20 m and a free span of 24 m for each arch.

It consists of three segmental arches of reinforced concrete with longitudinal diaphragms which allow the passage of the waters of the Urumea and the ebb and flow of the tides

The bridge is notable for the four monumental obelisks, located at its ends, which have a height of 18 m. and are crowned by sculptures.
